## Kia ora e te whānau

The wellbeing of the tangata we support and kaimahi/staff continues to be our top priority. We plan to move as safely as possible from Lockdown into Alert Level 3. We are extending our 'workplace bubbles' with extreme caution so we can keep the gains we have made in stopping the spread of Covid-19. We also understand the need to support the rights of tangata and their whānau to expand their bubbles alongside the need to keep tangata, kaimahi and their whānau as safe as possible as restrictions, on moving between bubbles, are lifted.

- Because we are an essential service we will continue to operate in a restricted way, very close to the way we have operated under Lockdown.
- Our respite and vocational services will remain closed, so will our Auckland Community Centre, Te Rito.
- All our offices will remain closed during the Alert Level 3 period. Skeleton staff only will be in the office on an as needed basis.
- If you have a whānaunga/relative living in one of our whare and you want to visit
  them you will need permission from the Service Manager prior to any visit taking
  place. We are required to have strict infection control and contact tracing
