We have reminded kaimahi:

- If they are sick, they should stay at home.
- If they have flu-like symptoms they should report it to their GP or Healthline 0800 358 5453.
- That they are to continue with good hygiene practices.

- If you want to visit tangata you will need to let the whare know, at least one day in advance. If it is easier for you, the Kaitaataki can take you through the questions over the phone and fill out the form for you.
