Kia ora e te whānau

- **The Prime Minister** has announced that all of Auckland moved into **Alert Level 3** late last night, for **three days**. Our Auckland Office will be closed from 8.30am Monday 15 February until Thursday 18 February. All our Auckland office based staff will be working from home. We are an essential service so we are still operating.
- Our services outside of Auckland have moved into **Alert Level 2**, from late last night. Our offices outside Auckland will remain open. Although the restrictions are not as tight as in Auckland we still need to be careful.
- For **Alert Levels 3 and 2** this means if you have a whānaunga/relative living in one of our whare and you want to visit them you will need to let the whare know, at least one day in advance, if you would like to visit the whare. The Kaitaataki of the whare will discuss what needs to be done before a visit can take place. **If it is OK for you to visit** there will be strict infection control and contact tracing requirements.
- Continue to regularly wash your hands, cough and sneeze into your elbow and wipe down shared surfaces
- Keep 2 metres distance in public and wear a face covering.
